4 Sep 1832 Frederick Pobst Application for Naturalization

Roster of Ohio Soldiers in the War of 1812, p. 19

Private **Frederick Pobst** is listed on the roll of <u>Capt. William McMain's (or McMean's) Company</u> which served from August 11, 1812 to February 11, 1813.

Bounty Land Warrant No. 33751 for 80 acres was issued under the Act of 1850 in favor of Elizabeth Pobst widow of Frederick Pobst deceased Private in Captain McMeans Company first Regiment Ohio Militia War of 1812. Elizabeth Pobst assigned the warrant to **Jacob Pobst** who was issued a patent for 86.84 acres in Brown County, Indiana on 1 Nov 1854

Bounty Land Warrant No. 40743 for 80 acres was issued under the Act of 1855 in favor of Elizabeth Pobst widow of Frederick Pobst Private Captain McMeans Company Ohio Militia War of 1812. The warrant was assigned by Frederick D. Pobst and Jacob Pobst executors of the last Will and Testament of the said Elizabeth Pobst deceased to James H. Hill who was issued a patent for 80 acres in Midland County, Michigan-Toledo Strip on 1 May 1867.

WARREN COUNTY, OHIO VIRTUAL CEMETERY PROJECT – FEBRUARY ADDITIONS

- Old Quaker Cemetery at Roachester The long missing gravestone for Ruth Tribbey (1764-1848) has been returned to the cemetery by the T & R Tarping Company who found it in a building that they were moving into in Hamilton, Ohio. They delivered the stone to the Warren County Genealogical Society library. Joey Hansted from the Morrow Area Historical Society picked up the stone and brought it back to the cemetery. Bob Hackman reset the stone back in its original location in the cemetery.
- Rose Hill Cemetery Finished adding gravestone photos for 320 burials in Section G3. Now have photos on line for 7,141 of the 10,421 known burials at Rose Hill. Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, B1, B2, B3, B4, B5, C1, C2, D1, D2,D3, E, G1, G2, G3, H1, H2, are now completed.

Our Virtual Cemetery Project now has photos on line for 64,595 burials in 95 cemeteries.

September Term 1832

Application for Naturalization

Personally appeared in open Court, a Court of Record, being the Court of Common Pleas within and for the county & State aforesaid Frederick Pobst, an applicant for naturalization who being duly sworn Declares and Saith: that he is fifty years of age, that he was born in the principality of Saxe=Coburgh=Gotha in the Empire of Germany from whence in the year Eighteen hundred he emigrated to the United States of America and has continued to reside therein ever since that time, that he has been a resident of Warren County in the State of Ohio for about twenty years past. And the said Frederick Pobst further declares & saith, that during his residence aforesaid in the United States he has been attached to the principles of the Constitution thereof, and well disposed to the good order & happiness of the same and that it has been his bona fide intention for at least three years past to become a citizen of the United States; and he further declares and says upon his solemn oath, the he will support the Constitution of the United States and that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiances and fidelity to any foreign Prince, Potentate, state or sovereignty whatever and particularly to his Highness the Duke of Saxe=Coburgh=Gotha to whom he was heretofore a subject, and the said Frederick also saith that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of the order of nobility in any country whatever, and further saith not.
