The digitization of War of 1812 pension files continues on fold3 and has Ohio pension files on line up to the name **Samuel Quinn**. We have not seen any announcements on when the rest of the collection will be put on line.

PHILIP OLINGER (CA. 1788-1841) WAR OF 1812 PENSION FILE

[War of 1812 Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files](#), "fold3.com, **Philip Olinger (21 pages)**

On 27 Oct 1813, **Philip Olinger** enlisted at Dayton, Ohio for one year as a Private in Capt. **Samuel McCormick's** Company, U.S. Rangers. He was honorably discharged at Dayton, Ohio on 27 Oct 1814.

On 20 Feb 1817, **Phillip Olinger** was married to **Nancy Gustin** [by consent of her father] in Warren County, Ohio [by **John Blair, J.P.** Nancy died on 13 Jun 1835 at age 36 & and was buried in the Warrick Rhodes Cemetery.]

On 12 May 1836, **Philip Olinger** was married to his 2nd wife, **Mrs. Sarah Scarff/Scharff** at Red Lion in Warren County Ohio by **Isaac Death**, Minister of the Gospel. She was the widow of **James Scarff** who died in Virginia on 10 April 1827. [Other sources give her maiden name as Bloss.]

On 10 April 1841 **Philip Olinger** died in Red Lion, Warren County, Ohio as shown by affidavits by **Elizabeth Miltenberger** and **John Miltenberger**. [Philip was also buried in the Warrick Rhodes Cemetery.]

On 29 May 1856, **Sarah Olinger**, aged 58, made a declaration before **Wm. P. Peebles**, a notary public, for the purpose of obtaining Bounty Land under the Act of 1855. **John Gustin** and **Julia A. Scharff**, residents of Warren County, made declarations supporting her claim. [Bounty Land Warrant No. 57169](#) for 160 acres was issued under the Act of 1855 in favor of **Sarah Olinger** widow of **Philip Olinger**, Private, Capt. McCormick's Company, Ohio Militia. War of 1812. Sarah assigned the warrant to **George D. Drake** who was issued a patent for 160 acres in Bourbon County, Kansas on 1 Jun 1865.

On 22 May 1878, **Sarah Olinger**, aged 81, of Red Lion, Ohio made a declaration before **Alex Boxwell**, Justice of the Peace, for the purpose of obtaining a widows' pension under the Act of 1878 (Application No. 26037). **Geo. M. Olinger** [their son] attested to her declaration. **E. P. Crane**, aged 56, and **Orph Crosfield**, aged 78, both of Red Lion, gave supporting testimony. Sarah was admitted to a pension of \$8 per month commencing 9 Mar 1878 by certificate No. 12212 dated 26 Nov 1878. **Hiram Simonton** of Lebanon was her attorney. Sarah was last paid \$8 to 4 Sep 1879 and was dropped from the rolls for failure to claim her pension. [Sarah Olinger is buried in the Red Lion Cemetery.]

WAR OF 1812 BOUNTY LAND WARRANTS: JAMES HART (1776-1865)

Listed as Private **James Hart** in Roll of Captain **Theophilus Simonton's** Company, 1st Regiment (Mill's) Ohio Militia, which served from March 23 1813, to October 1, 1813

Unindexed Bounty-Land Warrant Application Files, 1812-1855 on Fold3.com

Bounty Land Warrant No. 14336 was issued under the Act of 1850 to **James Hart**, Private Captain Simonton's Company Ohio Militia War of 1812. He assigned the Warrant to **Thomas Dickey** who was issued a patent for 80 acres in Livingston County, Illinois on 10 Jan 1855.

Bounty Land Warrant No. 14528 was issued under the Act of 1855 to **James Hart**, Private Captain Simonton's Company Ohio Militia War of 1812. He assigned the Warrant to **Wilson T. Keever** who was issued a patent for 80 acres in Ringgold County, Iowa on 1 Jul 1859
