With the recent addition of issues through 1999, there are now over 157,000 pages online. There are some new searching techniques that we hope to share with you in the next issue of *e-News* and online that will help your research in these online issues.

Since the fall of 2018, our **Alleen Stephenson Digital Newspaper Project**, sponsored and maintained by the Warren County Genealogical Society, has provided free public access to digital images of the *Western Star* from 1807 through 1999 on the <u>Ohio Memory Project</u>. 
