ALLEEN STEPHENSON DIGITAL NEWSPAPER PROJECT - WESTERN STAR ANALYTICS

Since the fall of 2018, our Alleen Stephenson Digital Newspaper Project, sponsored and maintained by the Warren County Genealogical Society, has provided free public access to digital images of the Western Star from 1807 through 1922 on the Ohio Memory Project. In the 1st quarter of 2020, the site was used by 1,593 visitors in 2,413 sessions to make 40,167 page views. Since the inception of the project, 5,762 users have made 189,549 page views.

The digitization of the <u>War of 1812 Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Application Files</u> was on hold once they completed adding the pension files for surnames beginning with the letter **Q**. The project has resumed with surnames beginning with **RO**. In the Ohio pensioners, they have pensions up to the name **Seth St. John.** No additional pension files have been added for a couple of months now.
