In November, photos of all extant gravestones at the <u>Mount Holly Cemetery</u> in Wayne Twp were added to the Virtual Cemetery Project. Additional photos were also added for the <u>Deerfield</u>, <u>Miami</u>, <u>Turtlecreek Friends</u>, <u>Unity</u> and <u>Plum Run</u> cemeteries. With these additions, we now have on line photos available for 45,409 burials in 94 different cemeteries.

- => War of 1812 Pension Files: The complete pension files for <u>James Abbott</u>, <u>Abraham Baker</u>, <u>William Brandenburg</u>, <u>Thomas Breeding</u>, <u>Frederick Briney</u> & <u>David B. Buckles</u> are on line. The pension files are being digitized in alphabetical order by <u>Fold3</u>. They are up to the **CAMP** surname for Ohio.
- => Civil War Widow's Pensions available on <u>fold3.com</u> continues to grow and is now up to at least widow certificate number 110,693. See Warren County Widows' Pension Application File Index for Warren County soldiers whose pension files are available on line.
- => Warren County Civil War 150 Roll of Honor, December, 1862 \* 23 dead, 11 wounded, 2 POWs.
