Meeting on Wednesday, May 21, 2008 at 7:30 PM at Philippi Meeting Room of the Campus Center at the Otterbein-Lebanon Retirement Community, 585 State Route 741, (north of State Route 63), Lebanon, Ohio

The Warren County Recorder has the task of keeping the vital records pertaining to ownership in real estate (land) and to all encumbrances or liens upon it. Since the 1787 formation of the Northwest Territory, a Recorder's Office has been provided in each county. Ohio became a state in 1803. Warren County was formed from Hamilton County shortly thereafter, with lands in three distinct districts – "Symmes Purchase", "Virginia Military District" and "Congress Lands". In addition to property records, the Recorder's Office maintains copies of Veteran's Discharge papers (DD214) when filed by the veteran as well as Veteran Grave Registration Cards.
