### 1940 CENSUS COMMUNITY INDEXING PROJECT http://goo.gl/XzZ9i

The 1940 census has now been available for one month. In that time a broad on line community effort has indexed an amazing 25% of the census. Ohio is 10% complete and only 6 states are less than 10% indexed.

Warren County Genealogical Society currently has 24 people in our indexing group. We have indexed 9,891 records so far, led by Elizabeth Lowrey who has done 2,180 of them.
